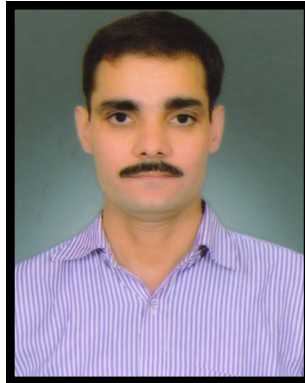

### **(i) Social Maniac**

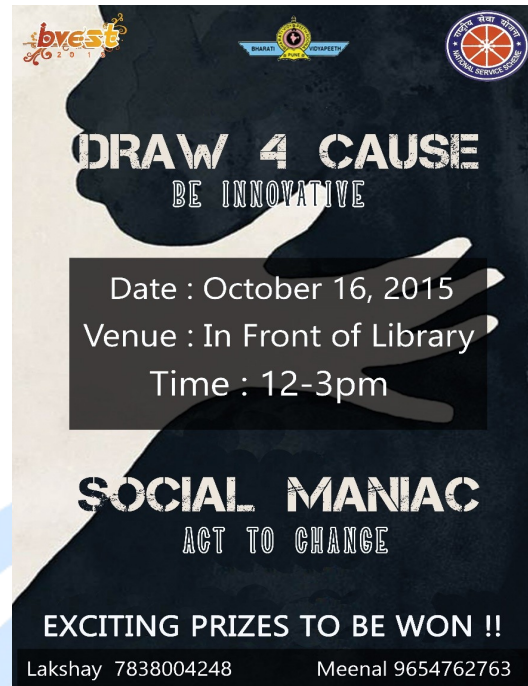

A creative event where participants will have to put on their thinking caps and create something on a social issue with usage of any letter.

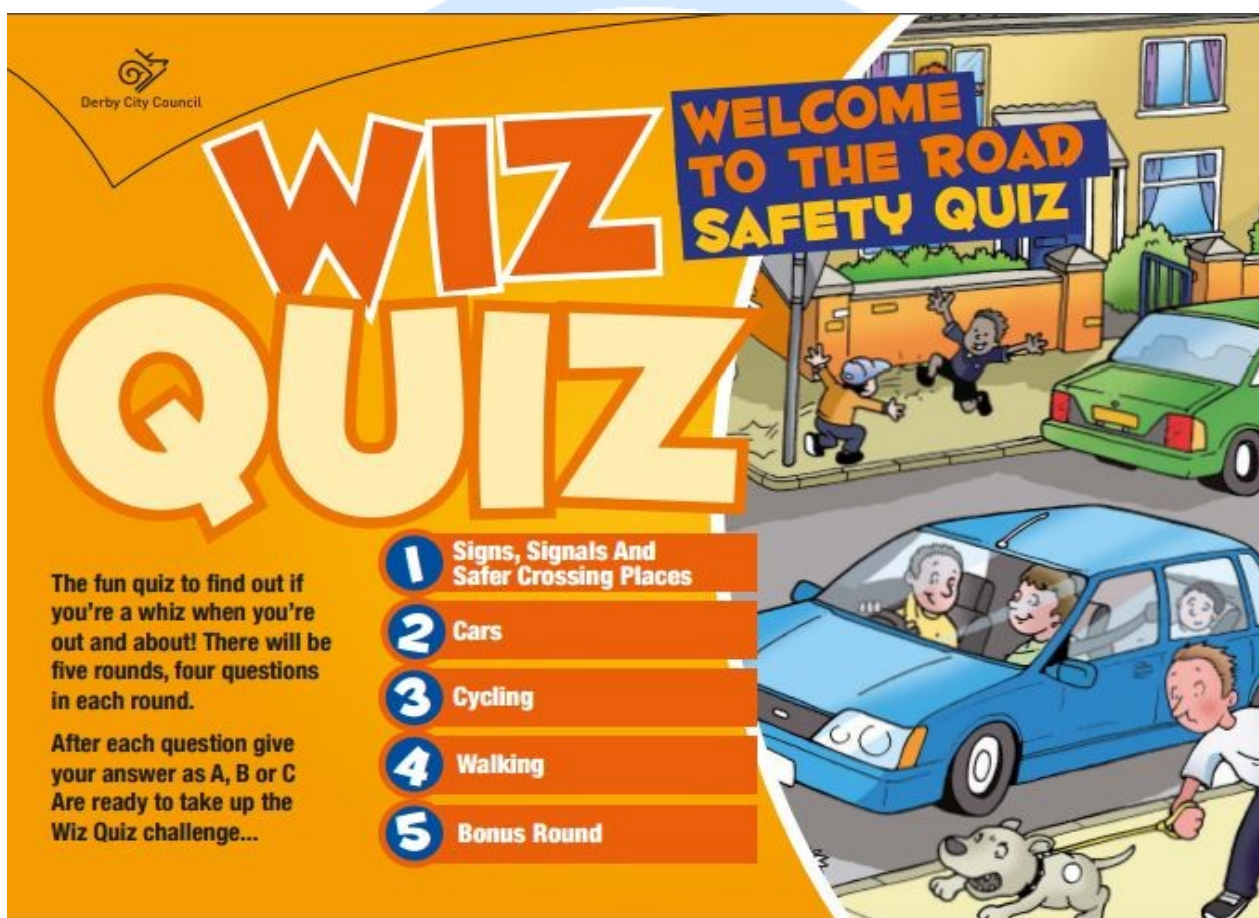
## 12. VIGILANCE AWARENESS WEEK, 2015

The objectives of the quiz competition on the occasion of Road Safety Week were as follows:-

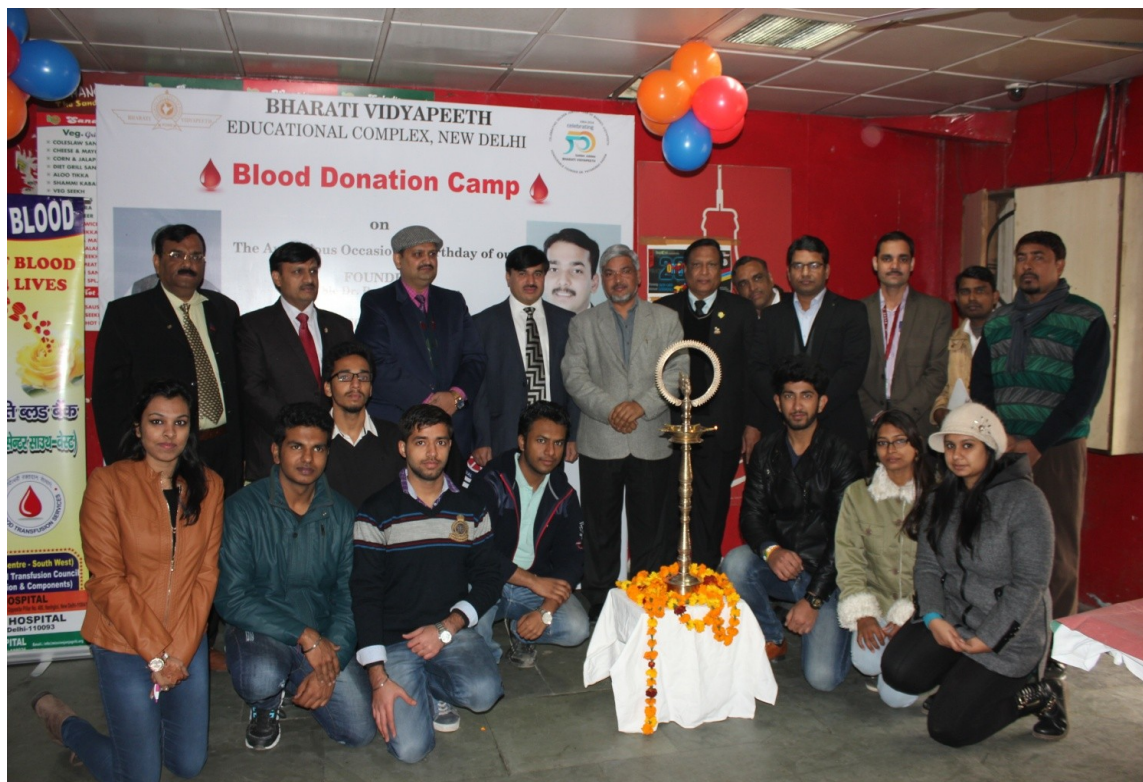
- To raise and maintain the awareness of students about road safety issues.

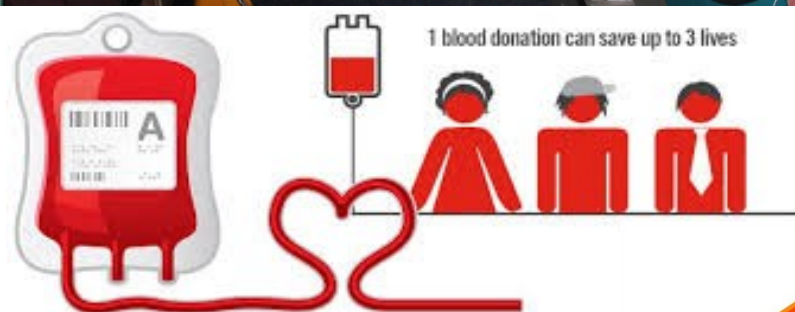
